### Achievements

- Has been a Professor for Sustainability Management at University of St.Gallen (HSG) since 1994. He co-founded the Institute for Economy and the Environment with Prof. Hans-Christoph Binswanger in 1992 and has since been its Managing Director.
- Has been publishing broadly in the areas of sustainability strategy and management as well as responsible management education, trying to connect research and teaching with practice and public engagement.
- Served as Dean of the School of Management (2001-2003) with responsibility for developing a first-time Bachelor in Business Administration as part of the European Bologna reforms
- Served as Vice-President for Teaching and Quality Development (2003-2011) with responsibilities for setting-up and developing a university-wide Quality Management System, for managing accreditations (EQUIS, AACSB, AAQ) and rankings
- Has been University Delegate for Responsibility and Sustainability since 2011 in charge of coordinating and developing activities and engagements about teaching, student engagement, public engagement, campus activities and operations, communication, national and international cooperation (e.g. PRME, GRII)
- Directs a specialization in Sustainability Management in the Master of Business Management and co-directs the Executive Diploma in Sustainable Business, developed and organized jointly with BSL Lausanne and endorsed by the World Business Council for Sustainable Development.
